





# Interview response summary

- Physical risk
  - Not a concern now, but a real concern going forward: Cape Town, population growth and climate change
  - Supplied by municipality more concerned
- Regulatory risk
  - Not heavily regulated at the moment, anticipate changes in the near future, acting proactively
  - Industry regulation and not municipality
- Reputational risk
  - Depends on nature and culture of business
- Financial risk
  - Not relevant in terms of volumes of water, but relevant for infrastructure and if regulations change
